This matter came before the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy for hearing on the 8th day of September, 1987, pursuant to Complaint and Notice of hearing No. 86-2-H (hereinafter referred to as "Complaint"), attached to and made a part of this order. Daniel Jacob, president, presided, with Norma McConnell, vice president, and members Martha Barron, Paula Bickett, Sumner Al Brooks, Simon Eisenberg, and Michael Noel in attendance and participating therein.

The State was represented by the office of the Attorney General, Montgomery Lee, Assistant Attorney General. The respondent, ERNEST KELLY BREWER was represented by counsel, Joseph Abodeely.

The Board, after consideration of the evidence and testimony presented, hereby makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

I

ERNEST KELLY BREWER is a pharmacist holding Certificate of Registration No. 2782 issued by the Board under A.R.S. § 32-1922.

Sufficient evidence was presented to substantiate charges 1. thru 10.

2 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4 That the Findings of Fact set forth herein above constitute sufficient
5 evidence to find that ERNEST KELLY BREWER is in violation of those state and
6 federal laws, rules and regulations contained in paragraph IV of the complaint.

8 The above described violations constitute grounds for discipline
9 pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1927.

12 In view of the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law the Board
13 hereby issues the following Order:

14 1. That the Certificate of Registration No. 2782 issued to ERNEST KELLY
15 BREWER be suspended for six (6) months. The suspension commencing immediately
16 upon receipt of this order and expires one hundred eighty (180) days there-
17 after.

18 2. That the Certificate of Registration No. 2782 issued to ERNEST KELLY
19 BREWER is on probation for a period of five (5) years to begin concurrent
20 with the suspension above.

21 3. That ERNEST KELLY BREWER must take and pass the Arizona Board of
22 Pharmacy law examination with a minimum score of 90% or be better, before the
23 termination of the one hundred eighty (180) day suspension.

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ERNEST KELLY BREWER is hereby notified he has the right to petition this Board for a rehearing with ten (10) days after receipt of this Order pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Rule R4-23-109.
