This matter came before the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy for hearing on the 9th day of September, 1987, pursuant to Complaint and Notice of hearing No. 87-6-H (hereinafter referred to as "Complaint"), attached to and made a part of this order. Daniel Jacob, president, presided, with Norma McConnell, vice president, and members Martha Barron, Paula Bickett, Sumner Al Brooks and Michael Noel in attendance and participating therein.

The State was represented by the office of the Attorney General, Montgomery Lee, Assistant Attorney General. The respondent, JACK NORMAN CIPARES was present and was represented by Michael B. Grayson, Attorney.

The Board, after consideration of the evidence and testimony presented, hereby makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

I

JACK NORMAN CIPARES is a pharmacist holding Certificate of Registration No. 3534 issued by the Board under A.R.S. § 32-1922.

II

Sufficient evidence was presented to substantiate charges "A" through "U"

1 contained in paragraph III the complaint.

2 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4 That the Findings of Fact set forth herein above constitute sufficient  
5 evidence to find that JACK NORMAN CIPARES is in violation of those state and  
6 federal laws, rules and regulations in charges "A" through "U" contained in  
7 paragraph III of the complaint.

9 The above described violations constitute grounds for discipline  
10 pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1927.

11 ORDER

13 In view of the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law the Board  
14 hereby issues the following Order:

15 1. That the Certificate of Registration No. 3534 issued to JACK NORMAN  
16 CIPARES be suspended for five (5) years immediately upon receipt of this order  
17 and terminating five (5) years hence.

18 2. That suspension of Certificate of Registration No. 3534 issued to JACK  
19 NORMAN CIPARES is stayed after six (6) months from receipt of this order  
20 provided that the following requirements are met:

21 A. Successful completion of an intensive outpatient substance abuse  
22 treatment program of the type offered by Cigna Health Care of  
23 Arizona, Inc. or the Alcoholism Council of Tucson, Inc.

24 B. Continued participation in aftercare groups for the duration of the  
25 probation.  
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C. Such program will be at the expense of JACK NORMAN CIPARES.

D. JACK NORMAN CIPARES will arrange for random monthly urine analysis performed by a Board of Pharmacy approved testing center with reports sent directly to the Board of Pharmacy by the facility.

3. Any unexplained positive controlled substance urine screen test will result in Board of Pharmacy reconsideration of the stayed suspension.

JACK NORMAN CIPARES is hereby notified he has the right to petition this Board for a rehearing within ten (10) days after receipt of this Order pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Rule R4-23-109.

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
