10 This Matter came before the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy  
11 on the 17th day of January, 1996 pursuant to a request by the  
12 Respondent, to amend the Order in the matter of 88-09-H by vacating  
13 the probation imposed. Gerald Ritt president presided, with members  
14 Daniel Jacob, Michael Noel, Natalie Spencer and Dennis McAllister in  
15 attendance and participating therein.

16 The Board heard testimony on the Respondent's compliance with  
17 Board Order 88-09-H including Continuing Education taken since the  
18 order. Staff instructed the Board that the State of Illinois had  
19 vacated the probation imposed on the Respondent's pharmacist license  
20 in that state on May 30, 1995. After deliberation on the testimony  
21 presented the Board unanimously agreed to amend the Order by removing  
22 the probation imposed in the Matter of Board Order 88-09-H. All of the  
23 requirements of the Order have been satisfied.


