7 This matter came before the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy for hearing
8 on the 18th day of January, 1989 pursuant to Complaint and Notice of Hearing
9 No. 88-12-H (hereinafter referred to as "Complaint"), attached to and made
10 part of this Order. Norma E. McConnell, president, presided with Michael Noel,
11 vice president, and members Martha E. Barron, Sumner "Al" Brooks, J. Edward
12 Saba and Linda Tansik in attendance and participating therein.

13 The State was represented by the office of the Attorney General, Timothy J.
14 Agan, Assistant Attorney General. The respondent MILTON LEE GREER was present
15 but was not represented by counsel.

16 The Board, after consideration of the evidence and testimony presented,
17 hereby makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

18 FINDINGS OF FACT

19 I

20 MILTON LEE GREER is a pharmacist holding Certificate of Registration Number
21 2636 issued by the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy pursuant to ARS § 32-1922.

22 II

23 Sufficient evidence was presented, including Matter of Accusation No. 1269
24 entered by the State of California, testimony presented by Joe J. Rowan,
25 Deputy Director of the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy, and admission of

1 Revocation of Pharmacy License Number PH 18835 issued by the State of California
2 to MILTON LEE GREER, respondent.

3 III

4 That the Findings of Fact set forth herein above constitute sufficient
5 evidence to find that MILTON LEE GREER is in violation of Arizona law, rules
6 and regulations as charged in paragraph IV of the complaint.

7 IV

8 The above described violation constitutes grounds for discipline pursuant
9 to ARS § 32-1927.A.11

10 ORDER

12 In view of the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law the Board
13 hereby issues the following Order:

14 1. That the Certificate of Registration Number 2636 issued to MILTON LEE
15 GREER be revoked effective February 10, 1989.

16 2. Further, that in the event that the State of California reinstates
17 Pharmacy License Number PH 18835 issued to MILTON LEE GREER by the State of
18 California, the Respondent may request an appearance before the Arizona State
19 Board of Pharmacy for the purpose of consideration to reinstate License Number
20 2636 issued to MILTON LEE GREER by the State of Arizona pursuant to ARS § 32-
21 1928.D.


22 MILTON LEE GREER is hereby notified he has the right to petition this
