10 Pursuant to the foregoing Consent to Entry of Order, the evidence and records compiled and  
11 contained in the file for MICHAEL P. WRAY and for good cause appearing, the Board on this 13<sup>th</sup> day  
12 of January, 2000 enters the following Finding of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Board Order in the  
13 Matter of Notice of Hearing 99-0030-PHR.

14 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

15 **I**

16 1. MICHAEL P. WRAY is the holder of Certificate of Registration Number 6396 issued by the  
17 Arizona State Board of Pharmacy which permits the holder to practice pharmacy in the State of Arizona.

18 2. That on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of December, 1999, MICHAEL P. WRAY did enter into a Consent to Entry  
19 of Order with the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy admitting that factual allegations contained in the  
20 Notice of Hearing Number 99-0030-PHR are true and accurate.

21 3. That MICHAEL P. WRAY admits to violations of A.A.C. § R4-23-204(D)(1) to wit:  
22 failure to produce original certificates verifying participation in 30 hours of Continuing Education for the  
23 period July 1, 1996 to October 31, 1998 as required for renewal of Certificate of Registration Number  
24 6396 pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1936.

25 4. That MICHAEL P. WRAY is aware of the fact that the conduct contained in the factual  
26 allegations constitutes grounds for disciplinary action as provided for in A.R.S. § 32-1927(A)(10).

1 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

3  
4 1. The Board concludes that it has jurisdiction in this Matter pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1927  
5 (A)(10) and 32-1925(G)(2). The Board concludes that MICHAEL P. WRAY did violate A.A.C. §  
6 R4-23-204 (D)(1) to wit: failure to produce original certificates verifying participation in 30 hours of  
7 Approved Continuing Education for the period July 1, 1996 to October 31, 1998 as required for the  
8 renewal of Certificate of Registration Number 6396 on October 31, 1998, pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-  
9 1936.

10 2. The Board further concludes that MICHAEL P. WRAY is in violation of A.R.S. § 32-  
11 1927(A)(10).

12 ORDER

13 III

14 The certificate of Registration Number 6396 issued to MICHAEL P. WRAY is placed on  
15 probation for two years commencing ten (10) days from the date of this Order. The probation may be  
16 terminated subject to the following conditions:

17 1. MICHAEL P. WRAY shall pay a one-hundred (\$100.00) civil penalty to the Board within  
18 60 days of the date of the Order.

19 2. MICHAEL P. WRAY shall complete forty-five (45) hours of ACPE Approved Continuing  
20 Education within one (1) year of the date of this Order. Said hours shall apply only to the failure on  
21 this Order and shall not be applied to subsequent renewals.

22 3. MICHAEL P. WRAY shall pay all fees and complete all Continuing Education  
23 requirements throughout the term of probation to maintain Certificate of Registration Number 6396.

24 4. MICHAEL P. WRAY shall obey all the laws and rules governing the practice of pharmacy.

25 5. MICHAEL P. WRAY shall appear before the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy or petition  
26 the board in writing to terminate the probation upon completion of the conditions outlined in

1 paragraphs (1.) and (2.) above.

2 6. If MICHAEL P. WRAY violates this Order in any way or fails to fulfill the requirements of  
3 this Order, the Board, after giving the Respondent Notice and the opportunity to be heard, may  
4 revoke, suspend or take other disciplinary action against the Respondent.
